Iluka Lends a Hand is our community partnerships program, offering support to events, initiatives and projects in the communities where we work and live.

Iluka Lends a Hand invites applications for funding twice a year – in April and October.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW BEFORE SUBMITTING YOUR FUNDING REQUEST

What we fund

To be eligible, the proposed community event, activity or project should:

- Align with Iluka's values and social investment focus areas
- Provide positive benefits to the local community and its members
- Be locally relevant and connected to Iluka's operations
- Reflect the diversity of the community

Some examples include:

- Sporting associations to purchase equipment/ uniforms
- · Local youth programs
- Training and capacity building for not-for-profit organisations

What we won't fund

- Individual or for-profit organisations
- State government agency requests
- · Political, religious, or sectarian associations
- Core government services such as education or health programs
- Projects where gender, racial or other discrimination is involved
- · Events or initiatives that have already occurred
- Operational costs such as rent, wages, utility bills
- Travel costs including accommodation and flights
- Merchandise including show bags and consumables
- Community events where entry may present a barrier to participation
- Individual registration fees and/or uniform costs
- Purchase and/or supply of alcohol

WHO CAN APPLY?

Not-for-profits and organisations that have initiatives or projects that will provide a benefit to the communities in which we operate. Head to <u>lluka.com</u> to find out more about the location of our operations and business interests.

We will consider a number of factors when we assess funding requests, including:

- if the initiative addresses a need within the local community
- the potential impact of the initiative on the community
- if there is a geographical correlation to our mining operations
- · other existing initiatives in the region.

HOW MUCH CAN I APPLY FOR?

This will be determined by the specific requirements of your initiative or program.

WHAT IF I HAVE RECEIVED FUNDING FROM ILUKA LENDS A HAND IN THE PAST?

All applications are assessed on their individual merits at the time of application. If you have received funding in the past, that does not exclude you from applying again, but we will take that into consideration during the review process.

CAN I TALK TO SOMEONE IN THE COMMUNITIES TEAM FOR SUPPORT DURING THE APPLICATIONS PROCESS?

HOW TO APPLY

- 1. Check the date. Make sure you are applying during an open funding round (see dates).
- Complete the Iluka Lends a Hand application form, and email a copy to communities.support@iluka.com.

You will find out the outcome of your funding request within 30 days after the closing date of your funding round.


