

### **Eneabba Mine Site Project Update**

Iluka Resources would like to thank members of the Eneabba community and all our stakeholders who recently joined us in discussions and participated in interviews about the progress and development of the Eneabba mine site.

Our project team met with a range of stakeholders from across the region, providing an update on the Eneabba Phase 2 project and presenting Iluka's plans for a proposed rare earths refinery at Eneabba. For members of the local community, a Community Forum was held on Friday 13 August 2021 at the Eneabba Recreation Club. We would like to extend a sincere thanks to the Eneabba Primary School's P&C Association for contributing to the success of the Forum, providing catering and co-ordinating kids activities across the evening.

Our discussions provided the project team with the opportunity to listen to feedback and better understand stakeholder and community concerns about the proposed rare earths refinery, as well as the community's aspirations for Eneabba and the region.

Iluka is still in the early project planning phase and we require a series of government approvals to progress the project to the next stage. However, we value genuine feedback from all of our stakeholders and the community and will continue to provide opportunities for input so that project planning and decision making is well informed.

Importantly through our consultation, stakeholders also told us how they would like to be kept engaged in the project and we are exploring the range of communication options discussed.

We also welcome your input into Iluka's Mid-West Regional Social Impact Assessment (SIA). This is currently being undertaken by Umwelt Ltd and seeks to inform Iluka's preparation of a broader social strategy for the region, with the intent to identify:

- impacts and opportunities associated with Iluka's operations in the Mid-West;
- how these can be managed and enhanced; and
- community needs and values and options for social investment that recognises community needs and aspirations and potential partners/collaborators.
