Josh Henke made it to the finals of the Apprentice Employment Network WA Inc Awards of Excellence 2019. The awards recognise outstanding achievements of apprentices and trainees who have committed themselves to achieving excellence in their chosen career. Josh started with Iluka as an adult mechanical apprentice in 2016. He completed his TAFE theory in one year instead of three years which enabled him to concentrate on the practical side of his apprenticeship.
