



Ngulya Village expansion: Enhancing comfort and community connections

Work is well underway on the expansion of Ngulya Village, which will soon offer 192 additional rooms, providing more convenient and comfortable facilities for our crew staying on site.

This significant upgrade ensures our workforce has access to quality accommodation while supporting operational efficiency. Beyond internal benefits, Ngulya Village remains the only accommodation option in the area, enabling us to host local community members and stakeholders when they are working nearby. This strengthens our connection with the region and reinforces our commitment to collaboration.

In addition to the increased accommodation, upgrades to central facilities—including the kitchen, gym, and recreation room—are also progressing following the recent award of the contract. These improvements aim to enhance the overall camp experience and promote the wellbeing of our workforce.

The expansion and facility upgrades reflect our ongoing investment in creating a safe, comfortable, and engaging environment for everyone who stays at Ngulya Village.



Project update: Advancing the Eneabba rare earths refinery

While the Ngulya Village expansion continues to progress, several key awards and milestones in the construction of the refinery have been marked.

The refinery gas feed pipeline tender is currently under evaluation, with the award expected soon. Manufacturing and fabrication of buildings are advancing, with a couple of deliveries scheduled before year-end. Belt filters are nearing completion, with three successful shipments this year. The final shipment is set for 15 December, wrapping up a strong year of progress.

Chain conveyors were completed and shipped in October, while work on dryers and calciners continues steadily. All 26 precipitation and saponification vessels have been completed, and bagging systems are progressing well towards completion.

Eneabba has welcomed several new starters this year, strengthening our team. To support safety and operations, we've also added a new Tatra fire truck and ambulance to site assets. Stay tuned for our next edition, where we'll share more updates on Eneabba's projects and progress.
